The Power of Intercession

When we say 'intercession', we mean prayer that stands in the gap on behalf of someone else.

It's the prayer equivalent of being Simon of Cyrene on the way to the crucifixion.

We take up a burden in prayer on behalf of someone else – if they can't, won't, don't know how to, or in partnership with them.

Zechariah 10:1

Between our invitation to be a prophetic community and the testimony of God's work amongst us – these are the lane markers of our intercession!

Together, we become able to carry greater weight than we can alone.
