Pray and Seek the Lord

Rather than a focus on discussion questions today: why not begin to pray and seek the Lord. Commit to this week – personally or as a life group:

- + Put on a few worship songs however that looks for you and don't focus on singing along, but rather on your response to God. Dedicate time to seeking the Lord together and prioritising engaging Him however you best know how to! Sometimes getting on our knees or faces is a great catalyst.
- + Open up the Bible to Psalm 63 and read it through— and then talk to the Lord about it. At times of reading ask the Lord to meet you in what the words are saying. Ask for His grace and begin to pray out of the scripture for yourselves.
- + Now do the same with a passage like Joel 2:12–32 or 1 Corinthians 2. Ask God to do in your heart what stands out to you as you read.

+	Seek the Lord together and see where it leads you – get comfortable
	doing it together in unity with the company of others. Express your
	prayer to the Lord. Let it move you to praise and worship Him, to repent
	of any awareness of sin that arises.

- + Call on His name for those you personally know who don't yet know Him. Meet with God on their behalf.
- + Come into the Prayer Room between 6am and 11pm Sunday Friday. Use the stations if you desire, pray through scripture as you read or simply spend the time with the Lord > desiring, seeking, responding to, calling on, communicating with, interacting with and engaging the Lord. Do it until your heart begins to come alive within you.
